Dear readers! Jesus uses the first stage of our journey with MPH to cure our hearts of all wounds and addictions. Do not become discouraged. A cure requires much patience, and can take a long time. If you offer your heart to Jesus, you can count on a cure. But you must meet the following conditions: start every day

by committing yourself to Jesus and Mary. Make prayer, work (study), and rest regular parts of your daily schedule. Where prayer is concerned, develop a personal contact with Jesus and Mary. Get to know Blessed Karolina Kozkowna, Mother Teresa, St. Faustina, Father Pio, and others. Be demanding of yourself. We suggest saying the Prayer of Pure Hearts every day, praying a decade or two of the rosary, reading a passage from scripture, spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, and frequent reception of the Eucharist. Monthly confession is extremely important, and do not hesitate to go more often if you have committed a serious sin. Whatever you do, put your whole heart into it. Study hard, but remember to balance this with wholesome recreation and a dose of fresh air. Practice a sport that you enjoy. Do not waste time

be kept in the foreground. It is all the more important when circumstances would have you tolerate evil, make light of it, especially when others behave this way. My dear friends! watching mindless TV shows. Try to fast in some way on Wednesdays and Fridays.

The Holy Father asks young people to be watchful and vigilant. "What does it mean to be 'vigilant'? – he asks – It means being a person of conscience. It means you do not try to silence or deform the voice of your conscience. Vigilance means calling good good and evil evil, without blurring the two. It means developing the good, and correcting, overcoming the evil in you. This is a matter of fundamental importance that cannot be downplayed or pushed to the background. I solemnly promise to pray every day, to read the Holy Bible, to go to Confession regularly, to receive Holy Communion as often as possible, and to live my life according to the Ten Rules of the Crusade for Love. Lord Jesus, be the one master of my life. Teach me to control my sexual desires and emotions. Help me avoid everything that weakens and enslaves the will: cigarettes, alcohol, and drugs.

Teach me to make love the most important part of my life. Blessed Virgin, my Mother, lead me along the paths of faith, to the very source of Love, to Jesus, that I may trust in Him only, and believe in Him alone. Amen!
